

Non-Profit Allowable Victim Assistance Fines, Fees, and Assessment Fund Lease Process and Procedures

If a non-profit wishes to use a portion of donated Victim Assistance Fines, Fees, and Assessment Funds towards the lease of a building, the following lease processes and procedures must be adhered to and the non-profit must always contact the Department of Crime Victim Compensation (DCVC) initially for review.

- 1. The non-profit MUST provide direct services to crime victims
- 2. The non-profit <u>MUST adhere to all donation guidelines</u> as outlined on the DCVC Donation Form (located at www.sova.sc.gov under the auditing tab)
- 3. The non-profit will be allowed 150 square feet per person providing direct services
- 4. The non-profit will be allowed to pay lease for those personnel only that provide direct service to crime victims. (The non-profit MUST forward a copy of all job descriptions to DCVC for review and accountability purposes)
- 5. If all personnel within the leased building provide direct services to crime victims 100% of the time, the lease MAY be paid at 100% (The non-profit MUST forward a copy of all job descriptions to DCVC for review and accountability purposes)
- 6. If the donated funds are received and used for a lease agreement, the non-profit MUST forward a copy of the lease agreement and ensure it outlines (1) the total amount of rent and (2) the square footage for the portion of the building used by the non-profit agency
- 7. The non-profit <u>MUST contact DCVC prior to using Victim Assistance Fines, Fees,</u> and Assessment funds annually if used for lease
