SUCCESSSES

TREATMENT PROGRESS

- ✓ All youth actively participate in their treatment including trauma counseling, medication management, and weekly CSEC focused group.

ACADEMIC PROGRESS

- ✓ 100% of youth being served are working toward high school diploma or GED.
- ✓ Youth enrolled in FLVS maintain an overall A/B average.
- ✓ Youth enrolled in GED aim to complete it within next three months.

GRADUATES

- ✓ Since opening the home in July 2017, two youth are presently enrolled and thriving and one youth successfully graduated the program as of November 13, 2017.

SERVICES

THERAPEUTIC HOME SETTING

- ✓ Each youth receives his **own room and private bath**.
- ✓ Home is structured as a traditional family setting with a great room in the center.
- ✓ Residential House Manager, “House Mama” has over 20 years’ experience working in residential foster care settings.

INTENSIVE CASE MANAGEMENT

- ✓ HERO HOUSE has a dedicated case manager.
- ✓ Youth are engaged in appropriate level of education.
- ✓ Youth receive all necessary medical, mental health, and DJJ services (including **bloodwork, PCP, Dental and vision, probation obligations, and counseling**).
- ✓ Life skills are taught and developed on a regular basis.
